#### **World Class Faculty**

#### **Simulation-Based Learning**

MBBS students can develop their clinical skills in the Clinical Performance Centre which offers a student-centred learning environment. UNPAZ provides simulation-based learning experiences that guide our students in bridging the gap between theoretical knowledge and clinical practice.

State-of-the-art simulators develop students' procedural skills. Interactions with SPs impart communication and professionalism skills to students prior to encounters with real patients in wards.

#### **Innovative Teaching**

The Immersive Learning Space (ILS) is a dedicated facility with a large range of resources and immersive technologies. It supports and enhances students' learning experience. Our students can manipulate, navigate and explore anatomical structures, interact with simulated patients (SPs), and participate in clinical scenarios in a safe, intuitive, and highly engaging manner.



#### Library

The library provides updated Medica information to students and teachers. The library reading room can accommodate about 100 students at a time. 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## **MBBS Program**

#### **Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery**

UNPAZ offers 5½ years MBBS program, Every student shall undergo a certified study extending over 4½ academic years divided into 9 semesters (of 6 months each) from the date of commencement of his date of completion of examination and followed by one year compulsory rotating internship. Each semester will consist of 120 teaching days of 8 hrs each college working time including one hour of lunch.





#### CLINICAL POSTING

At #unpaz, you train in the country's best hospitals. The facilities of the National Hospital and our opportunities for clinical posting represent a variety of settings and patient populations, preparing you to succeed in any situation your career presents.

During third to ninth semesters, clinical postings of three hours duration daily as specified in the table next is suggested for various departments, after introductory course in Clinical methods in Medicine and surgery of two weeks each for the whole classes.



#### **INTERNSHIP**

Students must complete 12 months of rotational internship in UNPAZ's affiliated Guido Valadares National Hospital in Dili, East Timor where they will be posted in rotation to different departments.

#### **Guido Valadares National Hospital**

Guido Valadares National Hospital (HNGV), formerly Dili National Hospital, is THE BIGGEST AND ONLY NATIONAL LEVEL HOSPITAL of East Timor.

It is located in the eastern part of the capital city of Dili. In 2003 the hospital was renamed after Guido Valadares, who was a government official of the Fretilin government in 1975.

The government has formalised the recognition of Guido Valadares National Hospital as a hospital that provides secondary and tertiary healthcare services to patients forwarded by regional hospitals from all of the national territory. The hospital is endowed of legal personality and administrative, financial and asset autonomy, integrated in the indirect administration of the State.

Healthcare professionals are from Cuba, Australia, the UNFPA, as well as local doctors. On a daily basis, English (HNGV's working language), Spanish, Portuguese, Indonesian and Tetum are used in conversation and in the hospital's clinical notes.

An autonomous institution, HNGV is accountable directly to the Minister of Health, and is funded directly by the Ministry of Finance, A referral hospital where your clinical studies will be centred at. During your time here, you will learn practical clinical skills using the finest equipment and simulation facilities, which include a simulated hospital emergency room, clinical skills and research labs, pathology resource centre, organ demo room, and problembased learning rooms.



## **#unpaz and India**

#### **Developing Ties With India**

UNPAZ has a commitment to develop and increase its links with India. To that end, a network has been established within the University to promote and coordinate activity related to those regions.

Relations between East Timor and India date back to the early modern period. Many Indians are employed as advisors in the various Ministries, UN agencies and international donors based in East Timor. There are also some Indian entrepreneurs, and others involved in trading and the restaurant business. Some members of the community have achieved prominence in the country such as former Defence Minister Roque Rodrigues. Manuel Longuinhos was a Prosecutor General and the first-ever surgeon in East Timor. There are also a few prominent Indian ecumenical and business families. Several East Timorese students study at Father Muller's educational institutions in Mangalore, Karnataka.

India was one of the first countries to establish diplomatic ties with Timor-Leste in 2002. Timor Leste supports India's permanent membership of the UNSC and co-sponsored the Resolution on Yoga in the UNGA.

#### the India-UNPAZ Initiative

The India–UNPAZ Initiative was created in 2024 as a mechanism to build and sustain partnerships between a passionate group of Doctors & Entrepreneurs from India and academics and researchers at UNPAZ. It acts as a hub to coordinate India-related activities across the University, and as a contact point for potential external partners. India–UNPAZ Initiative seeks to develop equitable partnerships with Indian management and university, leading to collaborative academic research of mutual benefit, and seeks in particular to support students and early-career researchers in developing such collaborations.

Within UNPAZ, the initiative aims to attract participants from across the University. Its strategy board includes representatives from UNPAZ & Indian management with an India focus. In addition, India–UNPAZ Initiative celebrate everything India and India Subcontinent at the university. ## Admission Requirements

## MBBS Admission Requirements:

- ▼ The candidate must be of the age of 17 years on or before the 31st December in the year of admission.
- ☑ The candidate must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology and English individually and secure at least 50% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology subjects of 12th standard. Students belonging to the reserved category (OBC/SC/ST) get a relaxation of 10%. Further, physically challenged students in general/ unreserved category get relaxation of 5%.
- ✓ Students are also required to qualify the National Eligibility Entrance Test (NEET). This is mandatory even if the student is planning to pursue his medical studies abroad.

This is essential for all students who wish to return to India and be eligible for appearing for FMGE/NEXT Examination.

## Admission Process

#### Step 1

#### **Submit Application**

Submit your high school certificates, scan copy of passport and passport size photograph.



#### Step 2

#### **Acceptance Letter**

Within two weeks of the application, the Admission Review Committee issue acceptance letter. Pay 40% of tuition fee against advance fee.



#### Step 3

#### **Submit Your Documents**

Submit your 10th & 12th Marksheet, Medical Fitness Letter, Police Clearance Certificate, Sponsor Letter, Bank Statement of last three months with minimum balance of US\$ 7000 and Yellow fever vaccination certificate in original to India Admission Office.



#### Step 4

#### Pay The Balance Fee

It takes minimum of one month in process after submission of documents. Now pay the remaining tuition fee, Accommodation charge if willing to stay in university campus and for Air Ticket.



#### Step 5

#### Fly To Timor-Leste

You are all set to fly to Timor-Leste. India Admission Office will inform the date of travel and the tickets will be booked for complete batch. University provides you Airport Pick up and Drop services.




#### **Fitness Club**

#### CLARIFICATION ABOUT THE LICENSE TO WORK IN TIMOR-LESTE AS A MEDICAL PRACTITIONER

The Ministry of Health would like to clarify that both Timorese and foreign students who have been conferred the Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) degree from a college/university offering a faculty of medicine program recognized by the Ministry of Higher Education Science and Culture are allowed to practice as a medical practitioner, after acquiring the registration and license in Timor-Leste.

Furthermore, any foreigner having a valid medical degree from a recognized medical college/university is allowed to practice in Timor-Leste as a licensed medical practitioner or pursue higher medical education. The practice of medical acts in Timor-Leste is subject to compliance with current legislation on the registration of health professionals.
