## STUDYING AT “DUNAREA DE JOS” UNIVERSITY

“Dunarea de Jos” University of Galati (DJUG) is an accredited higher education public institution, with more than 65 years of tradition in education. In 1948, the Faculty of Land Improvement was established in Galati, the first with this profile in the country. In 1951, 1955 and 1959, the Agronomic, Polytechnic and Pedagogical Institutes followed. Up until 1990, DJUG was the only Romanian higher education institution to organize study programmes such as: *Land Improvement, Land Measurements, Shipbuilding, Food Industries, Pisciculture and Fishing Techniques*. In 1974, the Pedagogical and the Polytechnic Institutes merged and established the University of Galati which was to acquire its current name (“Dunarea de Jos” University of Galati) in 1991.



At present, DJUG has 14 faculties that offer bachelor’s, master’s and doctoral programmes in engineering, sciences, humanities, economics, health, arts.



The most important institution for higher education in South-East Romania, with over 11000 students, DJUG undertakes the role of a cultural and civic centre, meant to contribute to the formation and dissemination of cultural values, as well as the role of a science and technology pole, supporting education, economic, and social institutions in the area. DJUG trains competitive specialists and provides consultancy and technical solutions to the socio-economic environment.

An important objective in the DJUG Strategic Plan for 2016-2020 is the continual intensification of the national and international inter-academic dialogue through enhancing the international dimension of the study programmes at DJUG, growing the number of bilateral agreements and partnerships, stimulating the international mobility of DJUG students, academics and researchers, and intensifying both national and international exchanges of good practices, with a view to assuring the quality of the didactic process in keeping with European standards.



### BACHELOR’S AND MASTER’S STUDY PROGRAMMES

In its 14 faculties, DJUG offers 81 undergraduate programmes, of which 3 in English and 1 in French, and 86 master’s programmes, 12 in English and 2 in French. The academic programmes leading to a bachelor’s degree cover a 3 to 6-year period (180-360 ECTS credits, depending on the study programme). The master’s programmes take 2 years (120 ECTS credits) to complete.

## DOCTORAL PROGRAMMES



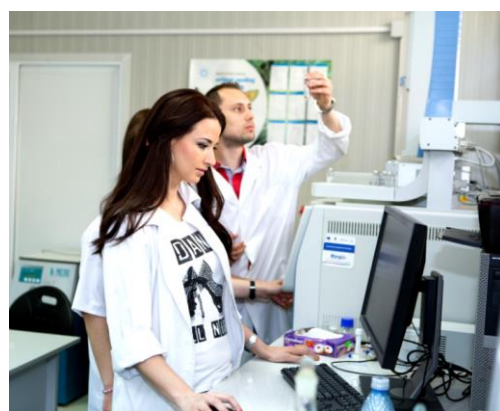

Three multi-disciplinary doctoral schools, the *Doctoral School of Mechanical and Industrial Engineering*, the *Doctoral School of Fundamental and Engineering Sciences*, and the *Doctoral School of Humanities and Social Sciences* organize doctoral studies in 14 fields, under the guidance of 83 doctoral supervisors. Full-time doctoral programmes take 3 years to complete.

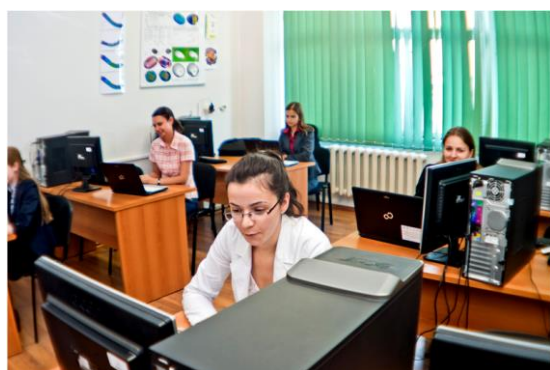

## CROSS-BORDER FACULTY OF HUMANITIES, ECONOMICS AND ENGINEERING

Currently, the Cross-Border Faculty of Humanities, Economics and Engineering (CBFHEE) has over 1,500 students (all citizens of the Republic of Moldova) and offers 8 bachelor's degree programmes and 11 master's degree programmes. All study programmes were introduced after a series of discussions with the local authorities. Thus, the activity of CBFHEE contributes to the development of a less favoured region of the Republic of Moldova (the south) and it is based on the collaboration with higher education partner institutions: The State Universities of Cahul, Comrat, Taraclia and Chisinau. The activity of FTSUEI is also based on a very close collaboration with the Romanian Consulate in Cahul.

A significant number of the graduates continue their education in master's and doctoral programmes at DJUG, some of them being involved in scientific research with significant results disseminated in conferences and national and international scientific journals. A large number of graduates have been employed in institutions and companies in the Republic of Moldova. Some of them currently teach at "B.P. Hasdeu" State University of Cahul or at DJUG.

The Cross-Border Faculty of Humanities, Economics and Engineering, kindly supported by the Consulate of Romania in Odessa, initiated a partnership with the State Pedagogical University of Ismail, Ukraine. This collaboration, which began a year ago, allowed the students in Ismail specializing in the Romanian Language to participate in a series of didactic training sessions in Galati. In addition, teaching staff from the University of Ismail were involved in teaching, research and management activities at *Dunarea de Jos* University of Galati.

This partnership was further consolidated in the academic year 2017-2018 by two undergraduate programmes, *The Romanian Language – The Ukranian Language* and *Managerial Assistance and Secretariat* which will become active in 2018, but for which a course of Romanian (preparatory year) has already been organized.

In the general framework of the same partnership, the activities carried out at the University of Ismail have been enlarged by including engineering on the list of available study domains.

Another important partnership was signed with the Cooperative – Commercial University of Moldova in Chisinau, where a series of negotiations have already been made with a view to co-organize two undergraduate programmes (*International Relations and European Studies* and *International Affairs*) and a Master Programme (*International Relations and Cross-Border Cooperation*).

*Romanian Studies and a Plury-Identity Dialogue – Contemporary Cultural and Teaching Paradigms* is another master programme which is run in the framework of the partnership signed with the Institute of Education Sciences in Chisinau.

## SUBSIDIARY OF THE FACULTY OF MEDICINE AND PHARMACY IN ENNA, ITALY

As a result of its tradition of performance, DJUG extends its academic connections across borders, with other European universities, by means of common research projects and programmes, offering educational programmes at both European and global high quality standards. In this context, DJUG has concluded a partnership agreement with the Kore University of Enna and with the Proserpina Fund.

The subsidiary is accredited by the Romanian Agency for Quality Assurance in Higher Education (member of the European Association for Quality Assurance in Higher Education - ENQA), the degrees obtained by the graduates being internationally recognised. The subsidiary of the Faculty of Medicine and Pharmacy in Enna has two study programmes – General Medicine (50 places, 6-year period of study) and General Nursery (50 places, 4-year period of study), all tuition fee paying places.

## SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH

Scientific research is one of the main components of professional development at *Dunarea de Jos* University of Galati (DJUG), representing an important assessment criterion for academic performance and visibility at national and international levels. The scientific research activity is carried out in traditional fields, as well as in new ones connected to modern trends in the scientific progress, with a fundamental and practical impact. Thus, training highly qualified human resources and increasing national and international visibility are key objectives, according to modern ethics and to the professional deontology principles.



The University promotes the development of a research environment centred on technological progress and innovation, competitive at national and international levels, which can consolidate the institution into a centre for excellence focused on generating knowledge and technological transfer, directly impacting the enhancement of scientific performance, the visibility and the quality of the services provided to the social and economic environment.

DJUG ensures the organisational and informational framework for elaborating, implementing and developing institutional policies and strategies, as well as assistance, counselling and logistic support for the members of the academic community, in view of launching and developing scientific research projects and disseminating the results via publications.



Our vision on the scientific research, development and innovation (RDI) activities and also on artistic creation focuses on the following:

- affirmation at regional and global level;
- excellence by internationalisation;
- recognition of regional leader in strategic domains, at the border between science and technology.

The strategic directions for research, development and innovation at DJUG, between 2016 and 2020, are the following:

- modernizing the existing research infrastructure and creating new ones for advanced research in strategic and border domains;
- consolidating the traditional research domains and developing new directions for research, in keeping with modern trends and the requirements of society;
- developing the innovation capacity;
- increasing visibility and recognition of DJUG at regional, national and international levels;
- assessing performance of research, development and innovation activities, and stimulating the research groups with solid results and international visibility.

The 38 units of research or artistic creation organised at institutional level carry out RDI activities in 6 fundamental domains (*Engineering Sciences, Mathematics and Natural Sciences, Biomedical and Biological Sciences, Humanities and Arts, Social Sciences, Sport and Physical Education Sciences*).

Starting from 2017, the academic resources (human resources and strategic infrastructure) involved in



excellence research, development and innovation activities are associated to „Dunarea de Jos” **Integrated Interdisciplinary Research Platform – ReForm**. In line with the Research, Development and Innovation Strategy assumed at institutional level, the **ReForm** platform represents a modern organizational framework for an efficient use of the university resources for multi, inter- and transdisciplinary extensive research, competitive at the regional, national and international levels with strong scientific, technological, cultural and social impact. The **ReForm** platform integrates the work of

performing research units with that of doctoral schools in order to increase efficiency, scientific performance, impact and visibility.

Between 2007 and 2017, DJUG has participated, as a coordinator or partner, in **90** international projects in the framework of H2020, FP7, FP6, COST projects, bilateral collaborations, Erasmus+, ENPI or partnerships with foreign companies (Dyadic, Zeelandia, Kemin, etc.)

Over the past 10 years, the university has concluded research partnerships with universities and research institutes from 43 countries.



## OTHER STUDY PROGRAMMES

**The Department for Continuous Education and Technological Transfer** offers postgraduate training and continuous professional development programmes, training courses, professional conversion programmes. The Department offers Romanian language courses for international students.

An important category of international students is represented by the Erasmus students. Currently, DJUG has signed bilateral agreements with 148 universities from 22 EU countries and one non-EU country (Turkey), most of which are with Turkey (17), France and Italy (20), and Spain (13).

In the framework of these agreements, students benefit from mobility grants for study or placement, academics - for teaching or training, and the administrative staff - for training.

Over the past two years, an increase in the interest of all these categories (both from DJUG and partner universities) in these type of mobilities was recorded, which consistently contributes to the international visibility of DJUG.

Starting with the 2016-2017 academic year, a course in Romanian language, culture and civilisation is organised for incoming students by the **Erasmus Office**, in order to support their integration.

## ROMANIAN AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE – PREPARATORY YEAR

Starting with the 2013-2014 academic year, DJUG organizes a one-year, full-time academic programme in Romanian as a foreign language. The course is meant for foreign citizens from EU third countries, who will be enrolled in undergraduate and graduate studies only after obtaining a certificate of linguistic competence (general, as well as specific vocabulary).

The course is organized by the **Department for Continuing Education and Technology Transfer**. The study fee is **220 Euro/month**.

## LIBRARY

The University Library has over 450 thousand volumes. The collections are organized by domains both at the central library and the 7 branches: Economic Sciences and Humanities, Medicine and Pharmacy, Engineering (in Brăila), Letters, Legal, Social and Political Sciences, Arts, and the European Documentation Centre.

Library users can read and borrow books, PhD theses, journals, standards, patents, electronic documents, and access scientific databases and Internet resources. The University Library has three computer networks. Library services are user-centred and include: provision of references, publication loan, inter-library loan, publication exchange, access to online library resources and the digital repository.

## CAMPUSES



DJUG has 9 residence halls offering state-of-the-art student accommodation. They are located in the three campuses: *Al. I. Cuza* (155 Domneasca St), *Științei* (111 Domneasca St), *22 December* (59-61 Gării St). With a capacity of approximately 2,500 places, the residence halls are equipped with modern bathrooms, 4-bed rooms, reading rooms, internet, and entrance surveillance cameras.

The campuses also host four canteens, fitness rooms, a first aid point with an ambulance, a social mediation centre where two counsellors are available daily to talk to students, a student medical centre (for general medicine), and laundry facilities which students can book online.
