HISTORICAL BACKGROUND AND GENERAL INFORMATION **ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY**

Medical education in Yaroslavl dates back to 1919, when a medical faculty was opened as part of the newly created university, which accepted 505 people for training. Among the teachers of the faculty there were remarkable scientists - professors M.I. Gramenitsky (physiology with biology), P.P. Dyakonov (anatomy), I.O. Zubov (history of medicine), E.K. Mezing (pharmacy), A.K. Nechaeva-Dyakonova (histology), I.P. Rozhdestvensky, A.V. Tikhonovich, S.E. Zimmerman (surgery), as well as well-known practitioners of medical institutions of Yaroslavl - A.G. Verzin, A.A. Golosov, V.V. Golubkov, G.I. Kurochkin, L.S. Landau, A.A. Malinin, A.F. OPOCHINSKY, V.L. Rosenfeld, N.S. Solovyov, G.G. Falk, S.S. Shah-Paronians and others. In 1924, the Council of People's Commissars decided to close Yaroslavl University. Nevertheless, the Faculty of Medicine managed to hold state examinations and graduate 88 doctors. Students of 1-4 courses (693 people) were transferred to other universities.

The decision to recreate a medical university in Yaroslavl was dictated by the Great Patriotic War, which required a multiple increase in the number of medical personnel. In 1943, the Belarusian Medical Institute began its work in Yaroslavl, formed from the evacuated Minsk and Vitebsk medical institutes. A year later, after the liberation of the western regions of the country, the university returned to its republic, and on its basis, by the decision of the Council of People's Commissars of the USSR No. 16725-r dated 15.08.44, the Yaroslavl Medical Institute was organized.

Since the foundation of the Institute, it was headed by professor V.G. Ermolaev, professor (Academician of the USSR Academy of Medical Sciences in the future) O.V. Kerbikov, associate professor D.P. Telkov, professor N.E. Yarygin, professor G.V. Stovichek, academician of the Russian Academy of Sciences professor Yu.V. Novikov, professor A.V. Pavlov. Since 2022, Academician of the Russian Academy of Sciences Professor A.L. Khokhlov is the rector.

The first graduation of doctors at the Yaroslavl Medical Institute took place in the summer of 1945. Diplomas were received by 53 graduates, 8 of them with honors. In the 50-60s, the university was replenished with highly qualified specialists, professors who came from Moscow, Leningrad, Kazan and other cities. Among them, N.E. Yarygin, M.G. Zaikina, A.I. Titov, S.V. Zakharov,

M.E. Kurmaeva, D.F. Zimbalist, N.N. Chumakov, V.N. Emelyanov, A.N. Alaev, A.A. Troitsky, G.K. Ushakov, N.N. Kochetov, A.K. Shipov, M.P. Vilyansky, L.M. Bedrin and others.

From 1955 to 1968, the Institute independently prepared 20 Doctors of Science and 122 Candidates of Science, and 7 Doctors of Science were graduates of the university. This is G.P. Babanov, M.S. Remizov, G.V. Stovichek, G.E. Saburov, G.V. Kurygin, V.N. Salyaev, L.K. Khokhlov. The departments of the Institute began to be headed mainly by his pupils, who became well-known scientists in the country and abroad.

The university developed, new faculties were opened: in 1970, the pediatric faculty was organized at the institute, in 1982 - the pharmaceutical faculty, in 1975 - the faculty of advanced training for teachers of medical schools, in 1979 - the faculty of specialization and advanced training of doctors. In 1989, on the basis of this faculty, a single center for postgraduate education was created, which structurally combined all forms of advanced training for doctors and pharmacists, residency and internship. In 1993, on the basis of the preparatory department and the medical-biological school, the faculty of pre-university education was created. Since 1992, the training of doctors and pharmacists for foreign countries has begun.

Since the millennium, the range of realized specialties was significantly expanded at the university. In 2010, taking into account the needs of modern healthcare and in accordance with the traditions of the dental school, the Faculty of Dentistry resumed its work. In 2011, training began under the programs of secondary vocational education, in 2013 it began under the higher education programs «Medical Biochemistry», «Clinical Psychology» and «Social Work». In 2015, the Faculty of Clinical Psychology and Social Work was opened.

In 1994, the Yaroslavl State Medical Institute was renamed into the Yaroslavl State Medical Academy, in 2014 - into the Yaroslavl State Medical University.

In 2015, in accordance with the Order of the Minister of Health of the Russian Federation, the scientific and educational medical cluster of the East European Central Federal District was formed, which currently includes the Yaroslavl, Ryazan and Voronezh medical universities,

Russian National Research Medical University named after N.I. Pirogov, Tambov State University named after G. R. Derzhavin, Russian Medical Academy of Continuous Professional Education, Crimean Federal University named after V.I. Vernadsky and the National Medical and Surgical Center named after N.I. Pirogov.

In 2017, two basic departments were created in Kostroma and Vologda, they are focused on the implementation of additional professional programs and practical training for students in the respective regions, in 2021, as part of the development of pharmaceutical education, on the basis of the testing laboratory of the Yaroslavl branch of the Federal State Budgetary Institution «IMCEUAOSMP» of Roszdravnadzor, the basic department of innovative pharmacy, in 2022 on the basis of one of the largest pharmaceutical companies in Russia JSC «R-Pharm» - the basic department of biotechnology and industrial pharmacy.

In 2022, in the course of reforming the Faculty of Pharmacy, taking into account the accumulated scientific and educational potential, the Institute of Pharmacy was created - a conceptually new scientific and educational complex that opens up broad prospects for the development of the pharmaceutical industry.

UNIVERSITY TODAY is a major scientific and educational center, which occupies a leading position in the system of modern higher and additional education.

After receiving education under the specialist's programs, university graduates have the opportunity to continue their education within the walls of the Alma mater under residency and postgraduate programs, and subsequently, being doctors, pharmacists, healthcare organizers, regularly improve their knowledge at the university through professional retraining and advanced training programs in the system continuing medical education.

MISSION OF THE UNIVERSITY is providing modern high-quality medical, pharmaceutical, psychological and social education, conducting fundamental and applied scientific research focused on the development of medicine, pharmacy and education, maintaining the health of the population, improving the quality of life of society.

Since its foundation, the university has trained more than 30 thousand healthcare and pharmacy specialists for the Yaroslavl, Kostroma, Vologda regions, the Komi Republic, other regions of Russia, as well as for the countries of Asia, Africa and America. More than 60,000 doctors, pharmacists and teachers have undergone various forms of professional retraining and advanced training. Over the years of the university's work, over 200 doctors and 800 candidates of sciences have been trained within its walls. Achievements of many graduates are well known outside our region and country.

Today, about 4 thousand students, residents and graduate students, including those from foreign countries, study at the university. More than 400 teachers work at 59 departments of the university, among which more than 100 have academic degrees of doctors of sciences and more than 300 academic degrees of candidates of sciences. The team of teachers includes two Academicians of the Russian Academy of Sciences, Honored Scientists, Honored Workers of Higher Education, Honored Doctors, Honored Health Workers and Honored Workers of Culture of the Russian Federation, members of public Russian, international and foreign academies.

To date, a flexible structure for continuous training of specialists has taken shape and is successfully operating at the university, including:

- pre-university training;
- training in programs of secondary vocational education and higher education (bachelor's degree, specialty, residency, postgraduate studies);
- additional professional education under professional retraining and professional development programs.

The training of doctors and pharmacists according to the target recruitment on the basis of contracts with the health authorities of the Yaroslavl, Kostroma, Vologda Vladimir regions, the Republic of Ingushetia, the Federal Medical and Biological Agency of Russia, the Federal Penitentiary Service of Russia, Russian Railways, etc. is widespread.

The university has a fundamental library with a reading room equipped with computers and copying equipment. The library fund is about 500,000 publications. All literature entering the library is entered into an electronic catalog based on the automated library information system (ABIS) «MARS», an electronic system for issuing literature has been introduced.

The university has its own educational and sports building for physical culture and sports, which includes 5 specialized sports halls and a wide-profile open stadium with elements of an obstacle course.

Memorable dates in the history of the university:

- 1944 – Order of the Council of Peoples Commissars of the USSR No. 16725-r dated August 15, the Yaroslavl State Medical Institute was organized, on October 2, 1944, the first classes began;
- 1946 – the first scientific conference of NMI teachers;
- 1947 – the first student scientific conference;
- 1954 – for the first time students of YMI participate in the development of virgin and fallow lands;
- 1960 – publication of the first collection of student scientific papers;
- 1963 – the opening of the Council for the award of the degree of candidate of medical sciences;
- 1966 – commissioning of the morphological building (educational building No. 4, Zagorodny Sad st., 11, building 4);
- 1966 – opening of the Faculty of Dentistry (worked until 1972);
- 1966 – the first independent student construction team (SSO) was organized at YMI;
- 1967 – the School of Medicine and Biology (MBS) began to work;
- 1970 – opening of the pediatric faculty;
- 1970 – opening of the Council for awarding the degree of doctor of medical sciences;
- 1972 – commissioning of the educational building No. 5 (Chkalova st., 6, building 7);

- 1975 – opening of the Faculty of advanced training of teachers of secondary medical schools;
- 1979 – opening of the preparatory department;
- 1979 – opening of the faculty of advanced training of doctors;
- 1982 – opening of the Faculty of Pharmacy;
- 1985 – commissioning of the educational and sports building (Chkalova st., 6 building 7);
- 1992 – the beginning of the training of foreign students;
- 1994 – Yaroslavl State Medical Institute was renamed into Yaroslavl State Medical Academy (YSMA);
- 1998 – launch of a full-featured YSMA Web site;
- 2007 – the first President of the Academy was approved - Academician of the Russian Academy of Sciences, Professor Y.V. Novikov;
- 2008 – publication of the first issue of the YASMA Student Newspaper;
- 2009 – commissioning of the theoretical building No. 7 (Chekhov st., 2);
- 2009 – opening of the Center for Mastering Practical Skills (currently a multi-profile accreditation and simulation center);
- 2009 – opening of the Russian Endoscopy Training Center;
- 2010 – resumption of work of the Faculty of Dentistry;
- 2011 – the beginning of the training of specialists in the specialties of secondary vocational education;
- 2011 – opening of the Youth Center;
- 2011 – creation of the Institute of Postgraduate Education
- 2013 – the beginning of the training of specialists in the specialties of higher education «Medical Biochemistry» and «Clinical Psychology» and bachelors in the direction of training «Social work»;
- 2014 – awarding the Academy with the status of the Yaroslavl State Medical University;
- 2014 – opening of the Museum of History of YSMU;
- 2015 – opening of the Faculty of Clinical Psychology and Social Work;
- 2015 – signing of an agreement on the creation of a scientific and educational medical cluster of the central Federal District «Eastern European»;

- 2016 – the beginning of the procedure for primary accreditation of specialists at the university;
- 2016 – participation of the university in the implementation of the pilot project of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation “Lean polyclinic” (“Creation of a new model of a medical organization providing primary health care”);
- 2017 – creation of basic departments of YSMU in Kostroma in Vologda;
- 2019 – the first graduation of specialists - clinical psychologists at the Faculty of Clinical Psychology and Social Work and biochemists at the Faculty of Medicine;
- 2021 – creation of a basic department of innovative pharmacy on the basis of the testing laboratory of the Yaroslavl branch of the Federal State Budgetary Institution «IMCEUAOSMP» of Roszdravnadzor;
- 2022 – creation of a basic department of biotechnology and industrial pharmacy on the basis of R-Pharm JSC;
- 2022 – establishment of the Institute of Pharmacy;
- 2023 – establishing International Faculty.

INTERNAL RULES FOR STUDENTS OF YSMU

(Adopted by the Academic Council of the University on September 21, 2016, Minutes No. 1)

1. General Provisions

1.1. The internal regulations of students of the federal state budgetary educational institution of higher education «Yaroslavl State Medical University» of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation (hereinafter referred to as the Rules) regulate the rights, obligations, the schedule of the educational process, the norms and rules of behavior for students, incentives and responsibility of students of FGBOU VO YSMU of the Ministry of Health Russia (hereinafter referred to as the University).

1.2. The rules are developed in accordance with the requirements of the Federal Law of the Russian Federation of December 29, 2012 N 273-FZ «On Education in the Russian Federation», the Charter and other local regulations of the University.

1.3. The rules are binding on all categories of students of the University, taking into account the characteristics of the type, level and form of education.

1.4. The rules apply to all students during classes and at other times of their stay in buildings, structures, premises, on the territory and other objects belonging to the University, as well as when students are at the clinical bases of the University and in other places outside the University in the performance of educational duties or participation in events organized and/or conducted by the University.

1.5. Issues not regulated by these Rules are regulated by the decisions of the Academic Council, the Council for the Management of Educational Activities, orders and instructions of the Rector, and other local regulatory legal acts of the University.

2. The rights of students

2.1. University students have the right to:

2.1.1. receiving education in accordance with federal state educational standards with a choice of the form of education and the form of education;

2.1.2. provision of conditions for learning, taking into account the peculiarities of their psychophysical development and state of health, including the receipt of socio-pedagogical and psychological assistance, free psychological, medical and pedagogical correction;

2.1.3. training according to an individual curriculum, including accelerated training, within the framework of the educational program being mastered in order;

2.1.4. participation in the formation of the content of their professional education, subject to the federal state educational standards of secondary vocational and higher education (the said right may be limited by the terms of the agreement on targeted training);

2.1.5. the choice of optional (optional for a given level of education, specialty or field of study) and elective (mandatory) subjects, courses, disciplines (modules) from the list proposed by the curriculum of the relevant educational program in the manner established by the local regulatory act of the University;

- 2.1.6. offset by the University in accordance with the established procedure of the results of mastering disciplines (modules), practice, additional educational programs in other organizations engaged in educational activities;
- 2.1.7. deferment from conscription for military service provided in accordance with the legislation of the Russian Federation;
- 2.1.8. respect for human dignity, protection from all forms of physical and mental violence, personal insults, protection of life and health;
- 2.1.9. freedom of conscience, information, free expression of one's own views and convictions;
- 2.1.10. holidays - planned breaks in education for recreation and other social purposes in accordance with the legislation on education and the calendar study schedule. Students in higher education programs after passing the final (state final) certification are provided, upon their application, vacations within the period of mastering the corresponding educational program;
- 2.1.11. academic leave in the manner and on the grounds established by the Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation, as well as maternity leave, parental leave until the child reaches three years of age in the manner established by federal laws and local regulations of the University;
- 2.1.12. transfer for education in another specialty and / or area of training, in another form of education in the manner prescribed by the legislation on education;
- 2.1.13. transition from paid education to free education in cases and in the manner provided for by the Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation and local regulations of the University;
- 2.1.14. transfer to another educational organization that implements an educational program of the appropriate level, in the manner prescribed by the Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation by local regulations of the University;
- 2.1.15. restoration to receive education at the University, in the manner prescribed by the legislation on education and local regulations of the University;
- 2.1.16. participation in the management of the University, including as part of public organizations and governing bodies of the University;

- 2.1.17. familiarization with the Charter of the University, with a certificate of state registration, with a license for educational activities, with a certificate of state accreditation, with educational documentation, other documents regulating the organization and implementation of educational activities at the University;
- 2.1.18. appeal against orders and orders of the University administration in accordance with the procedure established by the legislation of the Russian Federation;
- 2.1.19. free use of library and information resources, resources of the electronic educational and information environment, educational, industrial, scientific base of the University;
- 2.1.20. use of the infrastructure, cultural and sports facilities of the University;
- 2.1.21. development of their creative abilities and interests, including participation in competitions, Olympiads, exhibitions, reviews, sports events, sports events, including official sports competitions, and other public events;
- 2.1.22. participation in accordance with the legislation of the Russian Federation in research, scientific and technical, experimental and innovative activities carried out by the University, under the guidance of scientific and pedagogical workers of the University;
- 2.1.23. direction for training and conducting scientific research on selected topics, internships, including within the framework of academic exchange, to other educational organizations and scientific organizations, including educational organizations of higher education and scientific organizations of foreign states;
- 2.1.24. publication of their works in the publications of the University free of charge;
- 2.1.25. encouragement for success in educational, physical culture, sports, social, scientific, scientific and technical, creative, experimental and innovative activities;
- 2.1.26. combining education with work without prejudice to the development of the educational program, the implementation of an individual curriculum;

2.1.27. obtaining information from the University on the situation in the field of employment of the population of the Russian Federation in the specialties and areas of training mastered by them;

2.1.28. measures of social support and incentives in the manner prescribed by federal laws, the legislation of the Russian Federation on education, housing legislation, laws of the constituent entities of the Russian Federation, the Charter and local regulations of the University;

2.1.29. other academic rights provided for by the Law on Education, other regulatory legal acts of the Russian Federation, local regulatory acts of the University.

2.2. The University creates conditions that guarantee the protection and strengthening of the health of students. The study load, the mode of study and other activities that ensure the development of basic educational programs, good rest and health protection of students are established by the Charter of the University and these Rules in accordance with federal state educational standards and other standards approved by the education authorities.

2.3. Forcing students of the University to join public, socio-political organizations (associations), movements and parties, as well as forcing them to participate in the activities of these organizations and participation in campaigns and political actions is not allowed.

2.4. Students of the University have the right to free attendance at events not provided for by the curriculum.

2.5. Persons studying at the University on a contractual basis also have the rights stipulated by the contract for the provision of educational services.

3. Responsibilities of students

3.1. University students are required to:

3.1.1. comply with the requirements of the Law on Education, the legislation of the Russian Federation, the Charter of the University, comply with these Rules, the Rules for living in dormitories, as well as other local regulations of the University that regulate the legal status of students;

3.1.2. conscientiously master the educational program, fulfill the individual curriculum, including attending the training sessions provided for by the

curriculum or individual curriculum, and carry out independent training to classes, to perform tasks given by pedagogical workers within the framework of the educational program;

3.1.3. take care of the preservation and strengthening of their health, strive for moral, spiritual and physical development and self-improvement;

3.1.4. respect the honor and dignity of other students and employees of the University, not create obstacles for other students to receive education;

3.1.5. take care of the property of the University, be liable for damage caused to the property of the University in the amount and in the manner established by the legislation of the Russian Federation;

3.1.6. not to commit illegal acts that have socially dangerous consequences for the University, its students and employees;

3.1.7. immediately inform the University administration about the occurrence of a situation that poses a threat to the life and health of people, the safety of the property of the University;

3.1.8. not allow the use of the name, symbols of the University without the permission of the authorized bodies (officials) of the University, including for commercial and (or) political purposes;

3.1.9. do not speak publicly and do not make statements on behalf of the University (faculty, other structural unit of the University) without the appropriate permission of the authorized bodies (officials) of the University);

3.1.10. comply with the access control requirements at the entrance to the academic buildings and hostels of the University;

3.1.11. comply with fire safety requirements;

3.1.12. maintain the business reputation, honor and prestige of the University, not disseminate information discrediting the business reputation of the University, including in the media and in information and telecommunication networks;

3.1.13. do not allow violations of intellectual (copyright and related, inventive, patent) rights in the learning process, including the appropriation of authorship (plagiarism), as well as cheating, double change, forgery, fabrication of data and work results;

3.1.14. do not allow actions and (or) statements containing motives of political, ideological, racial, national or religious hatred and enmity, or motives of hatred

or enmity against any social group, including actions and (or) statements of a discriminatory nature on the grounds of sex, race, skin color, nationality, language, origin, property, family, social and official status, age, place of residence, relationship to religion, political opinions, belonging or not belonging to public associations;

3.1.15. comply with the orders and instructions of the University administration.

3.2. Students of the University must be disciplined and tidy, behave with dignity at the University, on the street, in a public place and at home, comply with the requirements for the appearance of students at the University established by these rules.

3.3. Persons studying at the University on a contractual basis also have obligations stipulated by the contract for the provision of educational services.

4. The order of the educational process

4.1. The educational process at the University is organized in accordance with the Charter of the University, the Regulations on the organization and implementation of educational activities of students in educational programs of higher education - undergraduate and specialist programs - YSMU of the Ministry of Health of Russia, as well as calendar schedules and curricula of ongoing educational programs.

4.2. The dates for the beginning and end of the academic year for students are established by the curriculum and calendar curriculum of the educational program in a particular area of training or specialty.

4.3. The academic year for full-time and part-time forms of study begins on September 1. The start date of the academic year for full-time and part-time forms of education may be postponed, but not more than 2 months. For part-time education, as well as for a combination of various forms of education, the start date of the academic year is set by the University.

4.4. The teaching of the disciplines of the educational program within the framework of the semester is organized according to the frontal and / or block principle.

4.5. The frontal principle of teaching provides for an even distribution of the teaching load and conducting classes in the discipline throughout the semester.

4.6. The block principle of teaching provides for the concentration of the study load and the conduct of classes in the discipline for several academic days of the semester, following one after another. The block principle of teaching disciplines is used, as a rule, in senior courses and is associated with conducting classes at clinical and other practical training bases.

4.7. The maximum study load of students per week is set within 54 academic hours, including all types of contact work of students with a teacher and independent work of students in mastering the educational program and elective disciplines, established in addition to the educational program and not mandatory for students to study.

4.8. The complexity of conducting training sessions of various types, conducted both in the form of contact work with a teacher and in the form of independent work of students, is calculated in academic hours. The duration of the academic hour for all types of training sessions is 45 minutes. One lesson, conducted in the form of contact work with a teacher, includes several academic hours. Between training sessions, a break of at least 10 minutes is established.

4.9. The maximum amount of contact work of students with the teacher during the development of the educational program is:

- full-time education - 36 academic hours per week;
- on part-time and part-time forms of education in the amount established by the Academic Council of the University.

4.10. The minimum amount of contact work of students with a teacher during the development of the educational program is:

- full-time education - at least 27 academic hours per week;
- for full-time part-time education - at least 16 academic hours per week;
- by part-time education in the amount established by the Academic Council of the University.

4.11. The maximum volume of classes of lecture and seminar types in the

organization of the educational process according to the educational program is established by the University, taking into account the requirements of the relevant educational standard.

4.12. 36 academic hours are allocated for the preparation and passing of intermediate certification by students in the form of an exam.

4.13. Attending all types of training sessions and passing all forms of control, including current control, intermediate certification and state final certification, is mandatory for students.

4.14. With the beginning of classes in all educational and adjacent premises, silence and order necessary for the normal course of training sessions must be ensured.

4.15. It is unacceptable to interrupt training sessions, enter classrooms during classes, except in cases caused by extraordinary circumstances.

4.16. To conduct practical classes in classrooms, laboratories, classrooms, each course is divided into groups. The number and composition of academic groups is established by order of the Rector of the University.

4.17. In each group, the dean of the faculty appoints a headman from among the most successful, active, responsible and disciplined students.

4.18. The head of the group reports directly to the dean of the faculty or his deputy, ensures the execution of his orders and instructions. The head of the group directly interacts with the employee of the dean's office who supervises the corresponding course or study group, form of training, and executes his instructions.

4.19. The functions of the group leader include:

- personal records of students attending all types of training sessions and preparing for classes;
- submission of information about the absence of students for classes to the dean;
- monitoring the state of the academic discipline in the group at lectures and practical exercises, as well as the safety of the premises, educational equipment and inventory;
- timely organization of the receipt and distribution of textbooks and teaching aids among the students of the group;
- notification of students about changes in the schedule of studies.

4.20. The orders of the headman within the above functions are obligatory for all students of the group.

5. Norms and rules of behavior of students

5.1. Entrance to educational buildings and dormitories is carried out upon presentation of a student card or an electronic pass. Transferring them to other persons is strictly prohibited.

5.2. Staying in educational buildings on holidays and public holidays (in the absence of planned events), on working days after 22:00, all persons are allowed only with a special permission from the University administration.

5.3. Entry of students into the classroom after the actual start of classes and exit from the classroom before the actual end of classes by the teacher is allowed only with the permission of the teacher.

5.4. Students must comply with the requirements for appearance:

- leave outerwear in the wardrobe of the University;
- have a neat appearance, at the request of the departments, change into clean changeable shoes, put on medical clothes;
- to be in sportswear and sports shoes during physical education classes;

5.5. In case of non-attendance at classes, the student must notify the dean or deputy dean of the faculty and, during the first three days of attending classes, submit to the dean's office data on the reason for non-attendance and documents confirming the good reason for absence from classes;

5.6. Students are prohibited on the premises and on the territory of the University, as well as on the territory of the clinical bases of the University:

- distribute and consume alcoholic beverages, toxic and narcotic substances, be in a state of alcoholic, toxic, drug intoxication;
- smoking, including electronic cigarettes;
- use profanity, demonstrate antisocial behavior;
- create noise and other interference for conducting classes in educational and office premises during classes;
- to be in training and office premises in outerwear and hats, to leave personal belongings outside the places intended for their storage and locker rooms;

- violate the rules of access control and fire safety, be in the premises of the University without a document proving the identity and status of the student at the University;
- play gambling;
- carry out unauthorized removal and transfer to other premises of the University property from classrooms, reading rooms and other premises of the University, use the University property for personal purposes;
- use mobile communications during training sessions;
- use earpieces, telephones and other technical means of transmitting information during the current control of knowledge, intermediate certification and state final certification, except when it is provided for by the content of the control;
- use any means and methods of involving students of the University in online communities/associations, by disseminating false information, or information obtained not from official sources (including through social networks, by distributing leaflets, booklets, etc.);
- independently enter any information in paper and electronic media on recording the progress and monitoring the knowledge of students;
- damage the property of the University, apply any inscriptions and drawings on the walls, classroom tables and other places, paste and post announcements without the permission of the administration;
- carry out business activities on the territory of the University and dormitories, including hand trading, provide other paid services (cooking, repair, rental, video and sound recording, photographing, etc.);
- to carry out film, photo and video filming in secure and allocated premises of the University, as well as professional film, photo and video filming in the premises and on the territory of the University without the permission of the administration;
- to carry out the movement and parking of motor vehicles on the territory of the University outside the places specially designated for these purposes;
- to bring into the premises of the University alcoholic beverages, materials of a pornographic nature, materials aimed at inciting ethnic or religious hatred, pyrotechnics, explosives, flammable and toxic substances, firearms, gas, pneumatic, sports and edged weapons or their imitations;

- create by their behavior the prerequisites for the emergence of interpersonal conflicts, disruption of the educational process, training sessions or other events on the premises of the University, normal activities of the University or its structural divisions.

5.7. Students are prohibited from distributing in any form (including posting on the Internet information and telecommunications network) information constituting a medical secret obtained in the course of educational activities and outside of school hours, which is not provided for by the current legislation, including:

- personal data of patients (including last name, first name, patronymic; year, month, date and place of birth, family, social and property status, education, profession, income and other information);
- information about the fact of applying for medical care, the state of health, the diagnosis of the disease, the secrecy of adoption and other information obtained during the examination and treatment of the patient;

5.8. Students are prohibited from taking photo, video and audio recordings, transferring to machine media (including copying and scanning) images of patients, medical procedures and information contained in medical records, as well as images of corpses and cadaveric material (including copying from other information resources without their respective links).

6. Measures of students' encouragement

6.1. For special achievements in educational, sports, social, scientific, scientific and technical, creative, experimental and innovative activities, the following incentives can be applied to students:

- declaration of gratitude;
- awarding a diploma;
- rewarding with a valuable gift;
- Appointment of an increased scholarship;
- awarding the title of the winner of the competition.

6.2. Incentives for students are issued by order of the Rector of the University on the proposal of the Vice-Rector, Dean of the Faculty, Head of the Department in the manner established at the University and are brought to the attention of the

students of the group (course, faculty). Extracts from the incentive order are kept in the student's personal file.

6.3. The appointment of increased scholarships is regulated by the Regulations on scholarships and other forms of material support for students of FGBOU VO YSMU of the Ministry of Health of Russia.

6.4. Students of the University who have particularly distinguished themselves in their studies and scientific work may be nominated for nominal scholarships, including scholarships of the President of the Russian Federation and the Government of the Russian Federation, as well as other awards in accordance with the legislation of the Russian Federation.

7. Responsibility of students

7.1. For non-fulfillment or violation of the Charter of the University, these Internal Regulations, the Rules for Living in a Dormitory and other local regulations of the University on the organization and implementation of educational activities, disciplinary measures may be applied to students:

- remark,
- reprimand,
- Expulsion from the University.

7.2. The application of disciplinary measures to students is carried out in accordance with the requirements of the Regulations on the procedure for applying to students and removing students from disciplinary measures at the YSMU of the Ministry of Health of Russia.

7.3. The expulsion of students from the University is carried out in accordance with the requirements of the Regulations on the procedure for expelling students from FGBOU VO YSMU of the Ministry of Health of Russia.

8. Final provisions

8.1. Additions and changes to this Regulation are made in connection with changes in legislation, are adopted by the Academic Council on the proposal of the Council for the Management of Educational Activities and approved by the Rector of the University.

PREVENTION OF NEW CORONAVIRUS INFECTION - WHAT STUDENTS NEED TO KNOW

The novel coronavirus infection (COVID-19) is an infectious disease caused by the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus that primarily affects the respiratory system.

On March 11, 2020, WHO announced the start of the COVID-19 pandemic. As of August 27, 2022, the number of cases in the world amounted to more than 600 million (600 105 393) people, more than 6 million (6,484,109) deaths. In Russia on August 27, 2022, 19,359,066 cases of the disease were registered.

The main source of infection is a sick person, including those who are in the incubation (before the development of symptoms) period of the disease or an asymptomatic carrier.

The transmission of infection is carried out by airborne droplets, airborne dust and contact. The leading route of transmission is airborne, which is realized when coughing, sneezing, talking at a close (less than 1.5-2 meters) distance. It is possible to transmit the infection through handshakes, food, surfaces and objects. At room temperature, the virus is able to remain viable for 3 days.

The incubation period is from 2 to 14 days (average 5-7 days).

COVID-19 is characterized by:

- Increase in body temperature;
- Cough (dry or with a small amount of sputum);
- Shortness of breath;
- Fatigue;
- Feeling of congestion in the chest;

There may also be a sore throat, runny nose, decreased sense of smell and taste, signs of conjunctivitis.

Coronavirus infection is dangerous with the possibility of a sudden severe course and the development of complications!!!

Special risk groups include people over the age of 65 and people with chronic diseases (diabetes mellitus, diseases of the respiratory system, cardiovascular system, oncological diseases).

To prevent the spread of COVID-19, the University has special anti-epidemic rules to be strictly followed:

- Persons with signs of infectious diseases (fever, cough, runny nose) are not allowed to the University.
- At the entrance to the buildings and dormitories of the University there is a mandatory «entrance filter» - all employees and students are subject to non-contact thermometry.
- Persons with signs of infectious diseases identified during the day should be immediately isolated in a separate room until the arrival of the ambulance team.
- Gatherings of students (including at the entrance to buildings and dormitories, in halls, corridors, at the entrance to classrooms (premises), in common areas) are not allowed. Social distancing must be strictly observed (at least 1.5 m).
- It is recommended to use personal protective equipment in educational buildings and common areas of hostels. Regular hand sanitizing is recommended.
- You should follow the rules of personal hygiene, both during your stay at the University and outside it, regularly wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water, disinfect gadgets, use only individual personal hygiene items (towel, toothbrush, etc.)
- When the first signs of an infectious disease appear (fever, cough, runny nose), it is necessary to limit contacts, immediately seek medical help, report suspicion of an infectious disease to the head of the group and an employee of the dean's office.
- **The most effective measure to prevent the new coronavirus infection COVID-19 is vaccination.**

APPLICATION OF MANDATORY MEDICAL INSURANCE POLICY

All foreign students coming to Russia must have mandatory medical insurance for entire period of their stay and education, we recommend to purchase this certificate for yourself. All students coming to Yaroslavl from other regions must choose a medical insurance organization at their new place of residence - in accordance with paragraph 4 of part 2 of Article 16 of Federal Law No. 326-FZ On Compulsory Medical Insurance in the Russian Federation: “in the case of change of residence the insured person chooses an insurance medical organization at a new place of residence within one month”. To do this, you must submit an appropriate application to the insurance medical organization and put a mark in the CHI policy.

The Yaroslavl branch of JSC “Insurance company “SOGAZ-Med” annually implements field services for students of YSMU in order to issue compulsory medical insurance policies.

In accordance with subparagraph 3 of Article 16. Federal Law No. 326-FZ “On Compulsory Medical Insurance in the Russian Federation”, the obligation of the insured person is “to notify the medical insurance organization of a change in last name, first name, patronymic, identity document data, place of residence within one months from the day these changes took place”.

Taking into account the restrictive measures aimed at preventing the spread of a new coronavirus infection, the Branch expresses its readiness to ensure the presence of an insurance representative on the territory of the University, which will allow filling out an application for attachment on the territory of the Yaroslavl region without interrupting the educational process (information about the time and place will be announced later).





EDUCATIONAL PROCESS

Progress control

Progress control is carried out in accordance with *«Regulations on monitoring the progress of students in educational programs of higher education - bachelor's programs and specialist's programs» and «Regulations on monitoring the progress of students in educational programs of secondary vocational education.»*

The following types of progress control are established at the university:

- *monitoring of current performance* during practical classes and seminars (test control, oral surveys, assessment of written and laboratory work, solving situational problems, mastering practical skills, etc.);
- *midterm control* based on the results of mastering sections of the discipline (terminal test control, final classes, colloquia, written tests, etc.);
- *intermediate certification (attestation)* - exams, tests, certification based on the results of practice, certification on term paper.

Debt for monitoring current progress and milestone control (missing classes and control procedures, unsatisfactory grades, rating scores below the minimum passing) **is called current debt**. Students with current debt are not allowed to interim certification in the relevant discipline. Liquidation of the current.

Debts are spent on working off in accordance with the schedule established by the department and approved by the dean's office.

Debt following the results of an intermediate assessment (due to non-admission, failure to appear for an unexcused reason, receiving a “failed” or “unsatisfactory” grade) is called **academic debt**. Students with academic debts are deprived of the right to receive an academic scholarship and are not allowed by the dean’s office to the next intermediate certification.

The liquidation of academic debt is carried out in accordance with the schedule of re-examinations and retakes of tests, established by the relevant department and approved by the dean’s office.

Retaking exams in order to increase a positive grade is **prohibited**. Retaking the exam with an unsatisfactory grade during the examination session is **prohibited**. A student with an academic debt has the right to re-pass an intermediate attestation in the relevant discipline (practice) **no more than 2 times within the time frame established by the dean’s office of the faculty** within one year from the moment the academic debt was formed (**as a rule, the dean’s office sets a deadline for eliminating the debt within one semester**). Academic debt that is not liquidated within the established time frame is the **basis for expulsion**.

Rating system

For the most objective assessment of the achievements of students enrolled in higher education programs, the university has introduced a **faculty ranking system**, which is regulated by the “*Regulations on the Faculty Ranking of Students in Educational Programs of Higher Education - Bachelor’s and Specialist’s Programs*”.

Faculty ranking consists of three components:

- rating of educational activity,
- rating of research activities,
- rating of extracurricular activities (social, cultural, creative, sports).

The rating of educational achievements is calculated annually based on the final rating for individual disciplines, the study of which was completed in the corresponding academic year, as well as the results of the annual interdisciplinary testing (starting from the 2nd year), taking into account the complexity of the disciplines. The indicator of labor intensity of each discipline is determined by the number of credits provided for by the curriculum in the specialty (field of study).

The final rating for each discipline is calculated at the departments in accordance with the *«Regulations on the rating system for assessing educational achievements of students in educational programs of higher education - undergraduate and specialist programs»* in relative numbers - as the ratio of all points scored for monitoring current performance, midterm control and points scored during the intermediate certification, to the maximum total score for the discipline.

«Traditional» assessment for each discipline («excellent», “good”, “satisfactory”, “unsatisfactory”, «passed», «failed») is also determined on the basis of the final rating in accordance with the scale:

The research activity rating is calculated by summing up the scores that characterize the degree and effectiveness of students' participation in the work of scientific societies, scientific events of various levels (competitions, conferences, congresses, olympiads), the preparation of scientific publications, and intellectual developments.

Ratings of extracurricular activities (social, cultural, creative and sports) are determined by points that characterize the degree and effectiveness of students' participation in volunteer, sports, cultural, creative and social activities.

Faculty ranking indicators are calculated annually and are used to justify the moral and material incentives for students, including the appointment of increased scholarships, the transition from paid education to free education, as well as in determining the priority for participation in scientific and extracurricular activities. The annual results of the rating are entered into the electronic portfolio of students.

Scholarship

Detailed information about scholarships is available on the official website in the section “For students”, subsection “Scholarships”.

Scholarship provision at the university is carried out in accordance with the *«Regulations on scholarship provision and other forms of material support for students.»* The following types of scholarships are provided for university students:

- state academic scholarship for students;
- State social scholarship for students;
- scholarships of the President of the Russian Federation and the Government of the Russian Federation;
- nominal scholarships;
- scholarships for students, appointed by legal entities or individuals, including those who sent them to study (for example, when studying in targeted areas).

The state academic scholarship is awarded to students depending on academic success based on the results of intermediate certification at least twice a year, provided:

- the absence of an assessment based on the results of the interim certification «satisfactorily»;
- absence of academic debt.

At the same time, **the payment of the state academic scholarship is terminated from the first day of the month following the month the student received the “satisfactory” grade during the intermediate certification, or the student has an academic debt.**

In the period from the beginning of the academic year to the passage of the first intermediate certification, the state academic the scholarship is paid to all

first-year students studying full-time at the expense of the federal budget.

Students who, following the results of the intermediate certification, have only “excellent” grades or “excellent” and “good” grades can be established state academic scholarships in the amount of up to 1.5 standards and 1.25 standards, respectively, established by the Government of the Russian Federation.

In addition, starting from the second year, students enrolled in educational programs of higher education, for special achievements in educational, research, social, cultural, creative and sports activities, can be assigned an increased state academic scholarship.

The state social scholarship is awarded to students who have the appropriate social grounds (see Section 3, clause 3.1 of the *«Regulations on scholarships and other forms of material support for students»*) **from the date of submission of a document** confirming the relevant grounds.

Students receiving a state social scholarship have the right to apply for a state academic scholarship on a general basis.

First and second year students who have grades of «excellent» or «good» or «excellent» and «good» and belong to the categories of persons eligible for state social scholarships or who are students under the age of 20 with only one parent - a disabled person of group I, **a state academic and (or) state social scholarship is assigned in an increased amount** (see Section 3, clause 3.5 *«Regulations on scholarships and other forms of material support for students»*).

Scholarships are paid **monthly**.

ELECTRONIC INFORMATION AND EDUCATIONAL ENVIRONMENT OF THE UNIVERSITY (EIOS)

During the educational process at the University, elements of e-learning and distance learning technologies are used. The remote format can be used when conducting training sessions, monitoring progress, intermediate certification, as well as in the elimination of current and academic debt.

The University has formed an electronic information and educational environment (EIEE), which is located on the platform <https://edu.ysmu.ru> and is designed to provide access for students and teachers, regardless of their location, to the electronic information and educational resources of the University.

To authenticate students, it is necessary to obtain credentials for authorized access to the EIEE: logins and passwords. After receiving logins and passwords, it is necessary to keep them secret, not to disclose, not to betray to other persons, while remembering the responsibility for the deliberate use of other people's credentials to enter the EIEE.

The first step in working at the University EIEE is the creation of a personal account and the formation of an electronic portfolio, which in the future will need to be updated regularly. Requirements for the design of an electronic portfolio and personal account can be viewed at this link:

First-year students on all emerging issues turn to their tutors. The tutors of the study groups provide instruction on how to work in the EIEE and advisory support.

On February 5, 2009, in accordance with the decision of the Academic Council, the Training Center for the Development of Practical Skills was established (currently the Multi-profile Accreditation and Simulation Center). The need to create the Center was due to the increased requirements for the quality of practical training of a doctor. The use of modern high-tech simulators in an artificially created professional environment opens up new horizons for the practical training of students, advanced training and assessment of its level among students, doctors and paramedical personnel.

The mission of the Center is to create conditions for the development of a wide range of professional competencies among students and the solid consolidation of clinical skills without the risk of harm to the patient.

The strategic goal is to provide students with the opportunity to develop, maintain and improve clinical competence and the formation of the ability to learn throughout life.

Currently, the Center trains students in the programs of secondary vocational education, higher education (specialist, residency, postgraduate studies) and additional professional education.

In 23 classrooms, conditions have been recreated that are as close as possible to the conditions of the professional activity of a medical worker.

In the process of developing practical skills, the emphasis is on the technology of performing one or another manipulation on the principle of modeling professional activity. Each student has the opportunity to immerse himself in an atmosphere close to the working conditions of a specialist. Modeling of professional activity in the educational process acts as a specific learning technology. Its essence lies in the fact that students reproduce professional activities in the learning process in specially created conditions when this activity is conditionally professional (“quasi-professional”) in nature, and when performing actions, operations, only its most essential features are reflected.



Training model the treatment room at the Center allows 1-2 year students of the medical and pediatric faculties to master, among other things, the skills of observing the basic principles of asepsis and antisepsis. The manipulation room model allows students to master the basic skills of caring for patients with pathologies of the cardiovascular, respiratory, digestive, and urinary systems.

In practical classes, 3rd year students of the medical and pediatric faculties practice the skills of caring for and treating long-term non-healing wounds, trophic ulcers, bedsores using the most modern dressings. 3rd year students practice the basic skills of performing pulmonary and cardiac resuscitation.

At 4-5 courses, classes are based on the principle of practical solution of situational problems, simulation of critical situations and emergency conditions in medical practice.

Students of the Faculty of Pharmacy in practical classes have the opportunity to immerse themselves in the atmosphere of a modern pharmacy. Classes for future pharmacists are held in the conditions of a pharmacy training model.

As part of the implementation of the educational program in the specialty «Dentistry», students take simulation courses in the practice rooms created on the basis of the Center of practical skills in providing dental care. The rooms are equipped with equipment for real dental practice.

Becoming students of the Yaroslavl Medical University, you become a reader of the YSMU scientific library, whose staff and funds will help you in your studies.

How to become a library reader:

- Registration of students of all categories is made on the subscription of educational literature on the basis of an order for admission to the university. An individual barcode and a photograph of the student received from the dean's office are pasted onto the library card.

About the library card:

- Presented at the subscription (educational, scientific) and in the reading room when ordering and receiving publications;

- Subject to annual re-registration with the obligatory presentation of all publications attributed to the reader. Readers who have not passed re-registration are not served by the library;

- In case of loss of a library card, the reader is obliged to write an application according to the existing model and apply for a study subscription, pay for the loss of a library card at the cash desk of the accounting department. Until a duplicate library card is received, the user is not served. A duplicate library card is issued after 10 days. The loss of a duplicate entails the deprivation of the right to use the library for a period established by the library administration.

- The library card is the only document giving the right to use the library. It is strictly forbidden to transfer it to another person, as well as to use someone else's library card.

Rules for using the library

Having received a book, journal or other publication, you are obliged

to check their condition and report any defects found to the librarian on duty. Otherwise, the responsibility for damaged editions is borne by the reader who used them last.

Remember that you receive publications for temporary use and must return them within a strict deadline.

Readers who have lost publications from the collection or caused irreparable damage to them are obliged to replace them with the same documents or equivalent ones recognized by the library (including copies of lost documents), and if replacement is impossible, they must reimburse their market value.

About the terms of use of publications:

At the subscription of scientific literature, scientific domestic and foreign publications are issued for a period of 10 days.

- Readers may extend the term of use of take-home publications if these publications are not requested by other readers. *Remote extension of the period of use of publications is available;*

- Educational literature is issued for a semester or academic year in the amount determined in accordance with the curricula and programs, depending on the duration of the study of the discipline. Readers are required to turn in the literature assigned to them after the end of the session until July 15 (the list is on the library website and on the library bulletin board).

- Readers can extend the term of use of educational publications if they are necessary for studying for one more semester.

- Students going on academic leave are required to hand over all the literature assigned to them.

- The following are not issued for home: magazines, newspapers, literature, available in a single copy.

- Terms of use of publications received on subscriptions to educational and scientific literature are not extended by phone.

The issuance of educational literature and classes for 1st year students on the basics of library and information literacy will be organized according to an additional schedule.
