



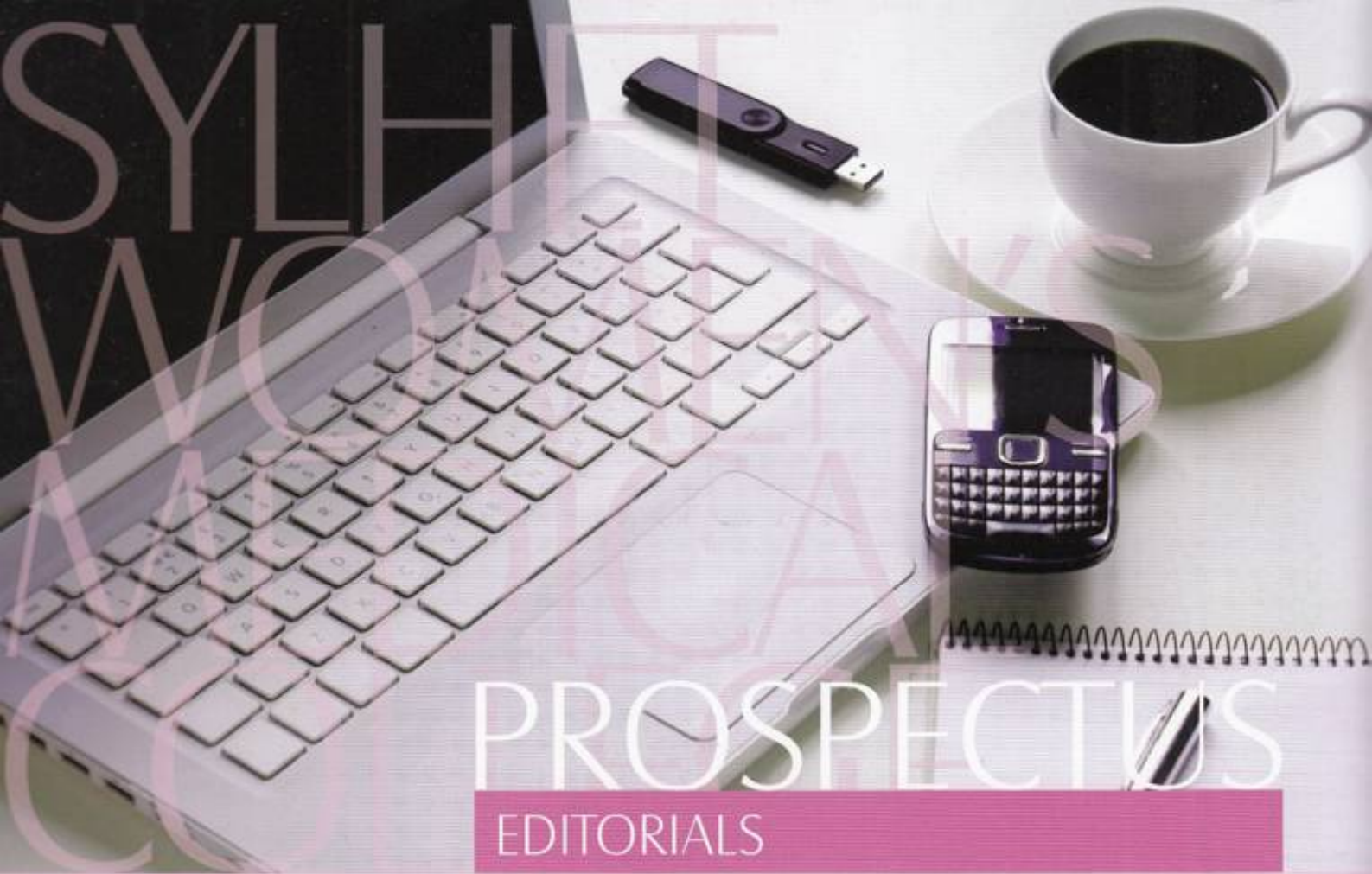

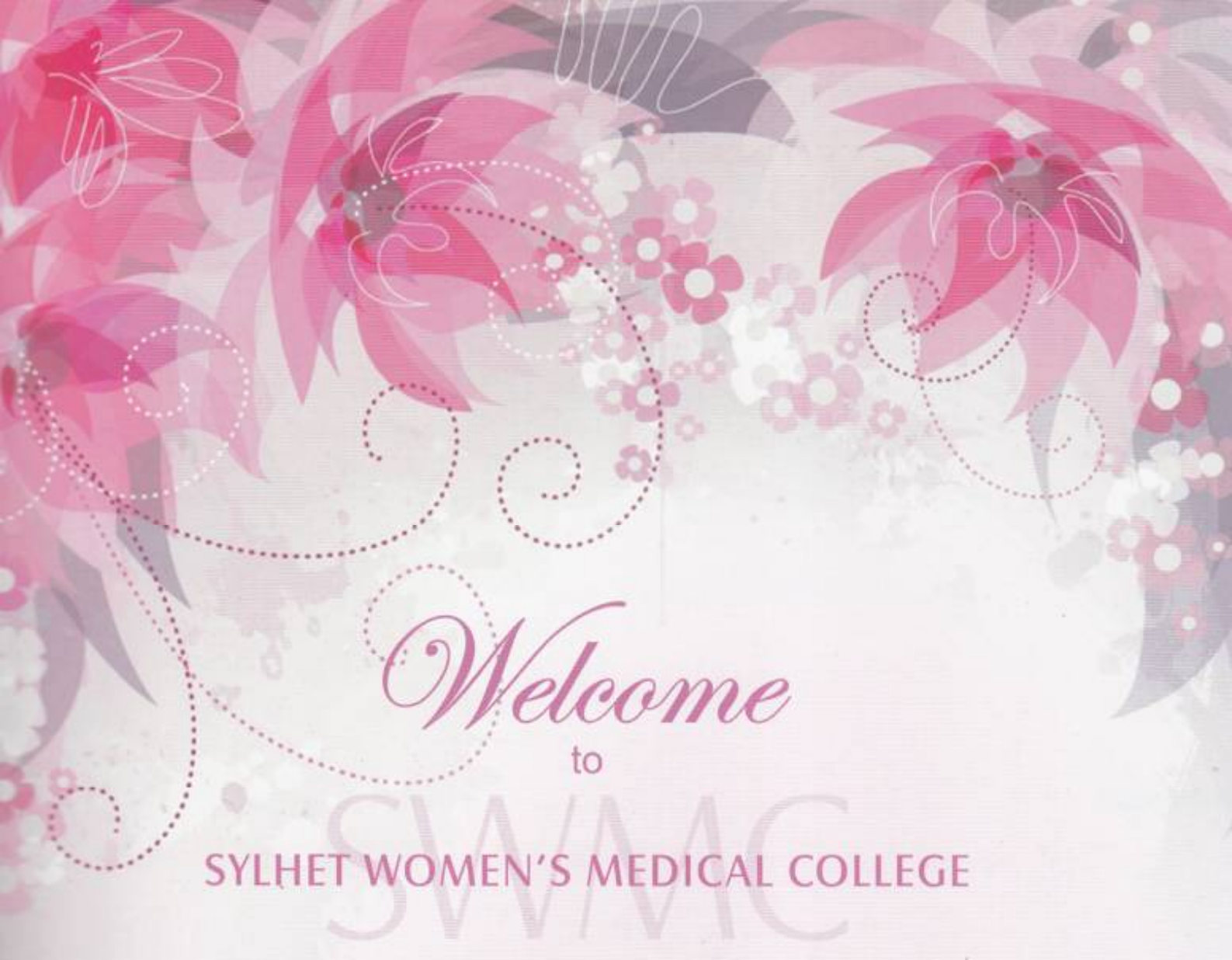

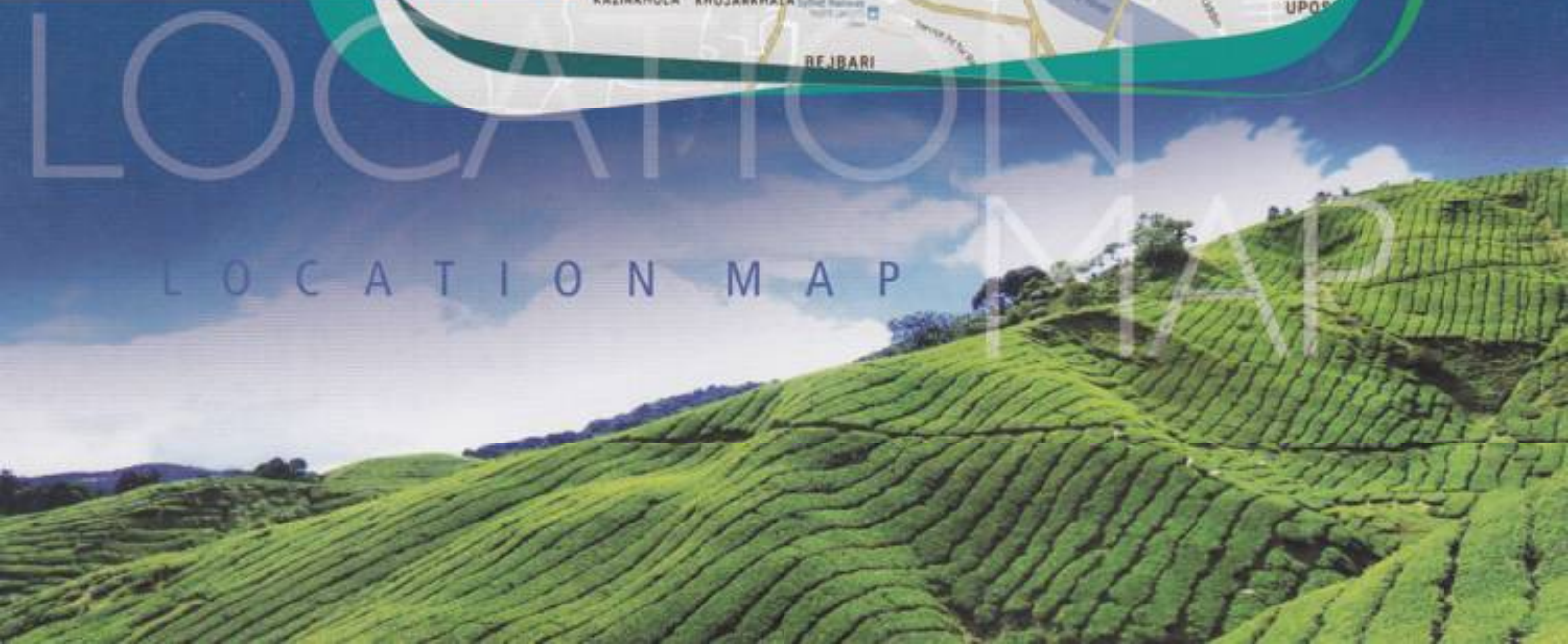

PREFACE

Beginning of this millennium, a group of philanthropist (NRBs, physicians, community leaders, local businessmen, engineers, teachers, and others) got together for a noble cause. Initially, the group was small, as the good news started spreading many others came and joined the group. Finally, in 2005 Holy Land Private Limited and Sylhet Health and Education Services Limited joined together for an even much greater noble cause in the field of medical education and health care. Message from the Director

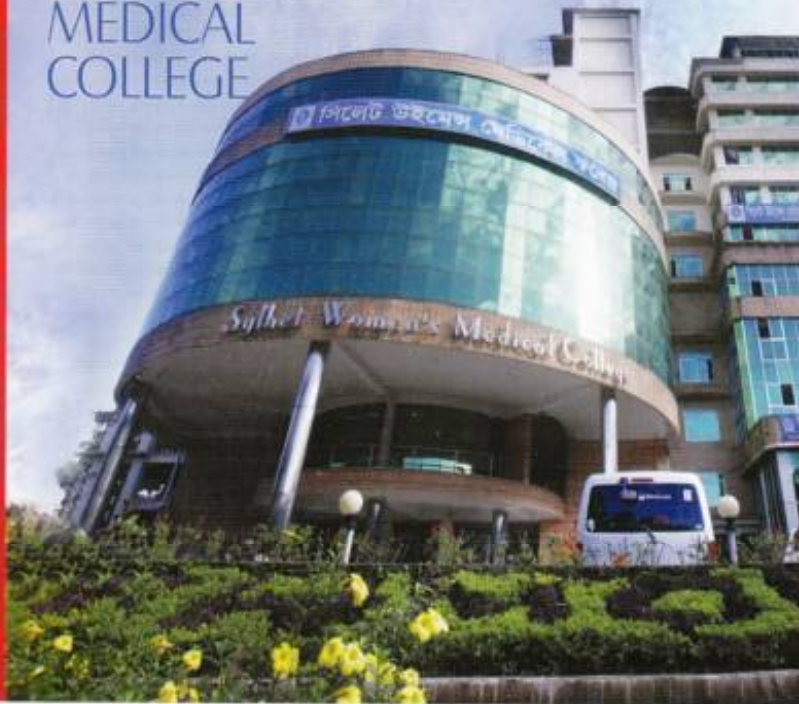

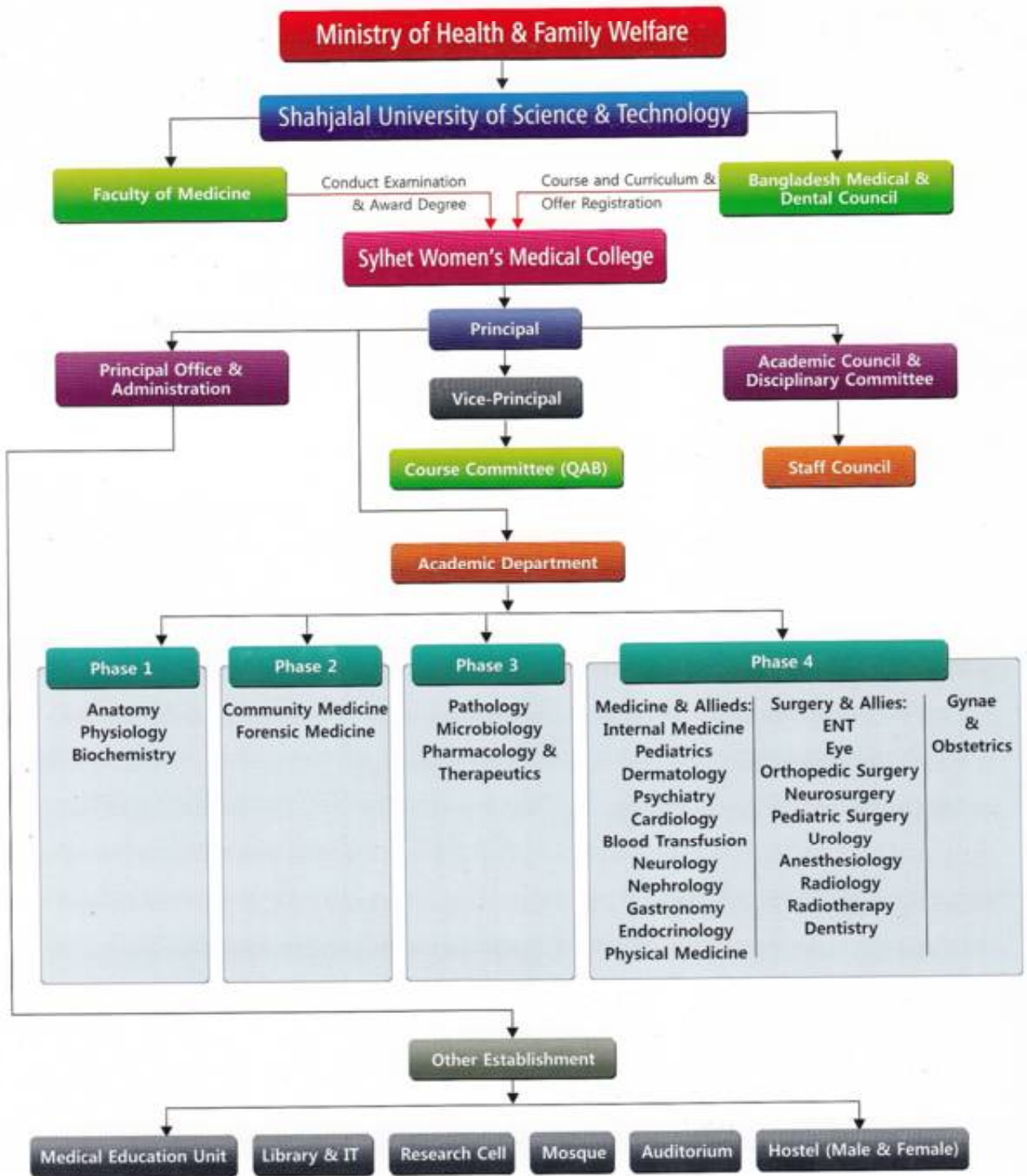

Academic Council

Course Objectives

At the end of the MBBS course students shall:

- ❑ Acquire knowledge and understanding of the sciences upon which medicine depends and the scientific and experimental methods.
- ❑ the structure, function and normal growth and development of the human body and the workings of the mind and their interaction, the factors which may disturb these, and the disorders of structure and function which may result.
- ❑ the etiology, natural history and prognosis of the common mental and physical ailments.
Students must have experience of emergencies and a good knowledge of the common diseases of the community and of ageing processes.
- ❑ normal pregnancy and childbirth, the common obstetric emergencies, the principles of ante-natal and post natal care, and medical aspects of family planning and psycho-sexual counseling.
- ❑ the principles of prevention and of therapy, including health education, the amelioration of suffering and disability, rehabilitation, the maintenance of health in old age, and the care of the dying.
- ❑ human relationships, both personal and social and the interaction between man and his physical, biological and social environment.
- ❑ the organization and provision of health care in the community and in hospital, the identification of the need for it, and the economic, ethical and practical constraints within which it operates, and
- ❑ the ethical standards and legal responsibilities of the medical profession.

- ❑ HSC or equivalent with Science (Biology, Physics, Chemistry).
- ❑ Candidate has to secure required grade point in the SSC and HSC examinations.
- ❑ Candidate has to secure required grade point in the MBBS Admission Exam.

Students selection procedure for MBBS course:

As per approval by the SWMC admission committee, selection will be made-

- ❑ According to the MBBS admission test merit list
- ❑ 5% of total students will be selected based on poor and meritorious quota / freedom fighter quota.

English

Duration:

MBBS course comprises of five years, followed by logbook based rotatory internship for one year.

Foreign students admission requirements

Foreign students need to apply according to the rules & regulation of their respective countries through their Embassies. Students need to collect equivalence certificate of S.S.C / 'O' Level and H.S.C / 'A' Level from the Director General of Health Services.

Pass Mark is 60% in each Written, Oral & Practical/Clinical Exam Separately

Marks and pattern of questions in written examination in each subject are distributed as, 10% of the marks of written examination for formative assessment, 20% for MCQ and 70% for SAQ (Except in Com. Medicine). There are separate answer scripts for MCQ examinations. Time allocation is 30 minutes for twenty MCQ questions for each written paper and two & half an hour for the SAQ questions.

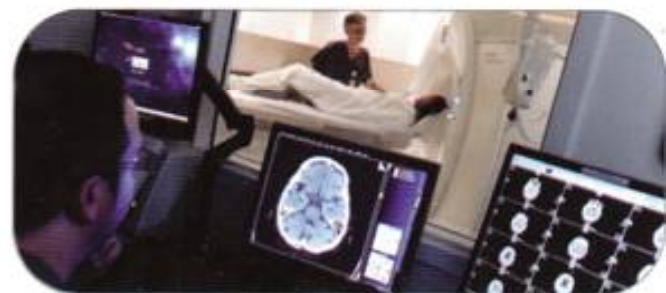

Admission Requirements

About Admission

Admission will be on the basis of merit following the terms and conditions as directed by the Govt. of the People's Republic Bangladesh. At present the admission process will continue as per latest government decision for the session 2016-2017.

Those who have passed 'O' and 'A' level or equivalent examinations in the specified years having equivalent examination in the specified years having equivalent marks also eligible to apply with an equivalence certificate from Director General of Health Service, Mohakhali, Dhaka.

Application Procedure

Application form, prospectus and other information are available at the office of Sylhet Women's Medical College and completed application form and relevant documents must be submitted to the office by the candidate or his/her representative in person with in the announced date and time.

Document to be attached

The students need to apply in prescribed form which can be collected from the principal's office. The completed form, along with the documents is to be submitted on or before the date as declared in advertisement.

1. Attested photocopies of the transcripts of SSC and HSC or equivalent Examination.
2. Attested photocopies of the certificate/testimonial of SSC and HSC or equivalent examination.
3. Four copies of recent passport size attested photographs.
4. Nationality certificate from Chairman of the Union Parishad/Ward Commissioner of Metropolitan City or National ID Card.
5. Money receipt of the purchased admission form
6. Admission form must be completed properly
7. Admit card from DG Health
8. Merit Score and Position of the exam taken by DG Health

In Course Exams & Internship

Incourse Examination

To conform to the need of the course and achieving high standard regular periodic class tests, assignments, item, card final and term final examinations are conducted by each department. The card final and term final examinations try to mimic the University conducted professional examinations. 10% of the marks of the written examination of each subject in the professional examinations are allocated to the scores obtained from in course evaluations and class attendants. Only those students, who would acquire at least 60% marks in the course evaluations and attend a minimum 75% of the classes, are allowed to sit in the professional examinations.



Internship Training

Students who successfully pass through the final professional MBBS Examinations are required to undergo one year compulsory Internship Training in a BM&DC recognized hospital which of course include Sylhet Women's Medical College. It is prerequisite for each medical graduate to be a BM&DC recognized registered doctor and thus achieving the legal status of providing health care service and prescribe medicine.

The trainees are also entitled an appropriate subsistence allowance/honorarium during the Internship. An Internship certificate mentioning the performance is issued by the Sylhet Women's Medical College hospital and academic authority.
